- 1. What are phrases you said growing up that aren't popular anymore?
- 2. How many phrases did you recognize from Jonathan's Gen Z list?
- 3. What were things your parents, coaches, or grandparents said or did that you thought were old fashioned previously?
- 4. How often do you think about Gen Z creating the culture that we are living in? What kind of future do you or your family want to live in?
- 5. Read Judges 2:6-11.
 - a. How long did the Israelities serve the Lord in verse 7a? (Their Lifetime)
 - b. Why did they serve the Lord in verse 7b? (They had seen all the great things the Lord had done.)
 - c. Verse 10 says a whole generation later didn't know the Lord or serve the Lord. Why do you think that happened?
 - d. What was the result of the next generation not knowing or serving the Lord in verse 11?
- 6. Read Deuteronomy 6:4-9.
 - a. Why did the author distinguish between "loving the Lord your God with all your heart, soul, and strength"?
 - b. What are we supposed to do with "these commands" in the verses?
- 7. Why does the next generation need this one to talk about their faith?
- 8. Is it easy for you to talk about what god is doing in your life?
