Pt. 4 - Discussion Questions:

1. What are phrases you said growing up that aren't popular anymore?
2. How many phrases did you recognize from Jonathan's Gen Z list?
3. What were things your parents, coaches, or grandparents said or did that you thought were old fashioned previously?
4. How often do you think about Gen Z creating the culture that we are living in? What kind of future do you or your family want to live in?
5. Read Judges 2:6-11.
 - a. How long did the Israelites serve the Lord in verse 7a? (*Their Lifetime*)
 - b. Why did they serve the Lord in verse 7b? (*They had seen all the great things the Lord had done.*)
 - c. Verse 10 says a whole generation later didn't know the Lord or serve the Lord. Why do you think that happened?
 - d. What was the result of the next generation not knowing or serving the Lord in verse 11?
6. Read Deuteronomy 6:4-9.
 - a. Why did the author distinguish between "loving the Lord your God with all your heart, soul, and strength"?
 - b. What are we supposed to do with "these commands" in the verses?
7. Why does the next generation need this one to talk about their faith?
8. Is it easy for you to talk about what God is doing in your life?
